Creating a “Speak-Up” Culture for Youth in OST

This training will focus on how to create an inclusive culture for all children and youth. We will explore implicit biases and how they can shape our perspective. Learn ways to build on the notion of “if you see something, say something” to create an accepting culture of community. Language and strategies that support open conversation and open mindedness will be explored. Concepts around staff identify, race, and culture will be addressed. How to Get and Keep the Staff You Want

Working with children is your passion but running a business may not be.
